



Instructions for Evangelism Volunteers - 2019

Before the Event

1. Sign up on Operation Care International's website
 - a. Scroll down on the home page and click on "Join the Team"
 - b. Pick the option "for the day of the event"
 - c. Then pick "Event Day"
 - d. Then pick which Evangelism area you want to work in:
 - i. Homeless side
 - ii. Family side
 - e. Register at Signup.com
 - f. Pick which time slot (morning, afternoon or all day) and whether Bilingual or English.
 - g. Before the sign-up is complete, you need to read and accept the "Evangelism Statement of Faith; Integrity Pledge; and Waiver".

2. It would be helpful if you became familiar with the attached copy of the **OCI - Evangelism Survey 2019** form that will be used for each guest. The form will be filled out with the guest's name and information before the guest enters the evangelism area. What you will be doing is recording the number of people accepting Christ on this form.

Also, if you do not have a personal way of sharing Christ with others, you can use the presentation given on this form.

Day of the event

1. Wear a red shirt. If you do not have one, there will be the official Operation Care International T-shirt for sale for \$10 at the Volunteer Check-in area. (All proceeds go to support Operation Care).
2. Do not bring anything that you may have to lay down such as a purse or jacket that you would need to take off. These items can sometimes "walk off" on their own.
3. Bring a pen.
4. Try to be at the Convention Center by 7:00 a.m.
5. There are several ways to get to the Dallas Convention Center.

- a. One is by car. If by car, then park in Lot E because it is **FREE!** See the attached: [OCI - Directions and Map to DCC including Lot E and J - 2019](#).
 - b. If by train, then take either the red or blue line to the Convention Center. There is a DART train station at the Convention Center.
6. When you arrive at the Convention Center, enter the Convention Center on the west side of the Convention Center for Volunteers. **This is different from the past.** The entrance is directly across the street from Lot E on the Hotel Street side of the Convention Center, see [OCI - Directions and Map to DCC including Lot E and J - 2019](#). The entrance is on the back side of Hall F. After entering, go upstairs to the second level and follow the signs to the Volunteer Check-in place. The Volunteer Check-in place is at the meeting rooms for Hall D, see attached [OCI - Floor Plan – Evangelism - 2019](#). After registering, go to either the Evangelism Homeless side which is Hall F or to the Evangelism Family side which is Hall D. The attached plan shows where these areas are located.
7. Welcome and instructions will be given in each evangelism area before the doors are opened to let in the guests into either Halls D & E for the impoverished family side or Hall F for the Homeless side. You will be paired with a guest (or guests) as they enter the Evangelism area. Chairs will be set up in order to talk to the guest in a comfortable setting.
8. After talking to the guest(s), you will lead them to the Evangelism area's exit and you will turn in the completed survey form.
9. Then you will line up to receive the next guest(s).
10. Bottled water will be provided.
11. Remember: We are sharing the Good News in the power of the Holy Spirit and leaving the results up to God!
